Supplies for activities needed:

- Markers - red, blue pink
- Writing utensil

Activity Name:

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Makes comparisons - Children are asked to compare the different pigs based on their size.
 - sorts objects - children have to separate each pig into a different size category and then, they're asked to color the pigs with the correlating size color. Ex. The smallest pig is colored red.
 - plans complex activity
- Instructions
 1. Color the SMALLEST sized pig RED
 2. Color the MEDIUM sized pig BLUE
 3. Color the LARGEST sized pig PINK
 4. Refer to example on page #3 if you are struggling with differentiating the sizes of pigs
 5. When the pigs are colored based on their size correlation, number the pigs 1-3. 1 = smallest, 2 = medium, 3 = largest, Put the number somewhere on the pig.
 6. When you are finished, show one parent or guardian your awesome work!
- Extension Activity Ideas
 - Children could cut out the pigs and place them in order from largest to smallest

- Parents or guardians could go online and find pictures of different animals and have their children compare realistic sizes of different animals. Ex. an elephant's size versus a dog's size.
