

Supplies for activities needed:

- Construction Paper
- Coloring Utensils (markers, crayons, etc)
- Glue
- Scissors

Activity Name: Alliteration Faces

School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:

- Increasing in ability to notice the beginning letters in familiar words

Instructions

1. First, have your child cut out a large circle out of a piece of construction paper. This is going to be their face.
2. Next, have them cut out a long strip of pink construction paper. This is going to be the tongue on their face. Have them glue it down where they want their mouth to be on their face. Then you can have them decorate and draw their faces as they wish, making sure to leave the tongue blank as this is where the alliterations are going to go.
3. Explain to your child what alliterations are (you can refer to this in the video) and have them think of one that includes their name. Help them write the alliteration along the tongue on the face that they made. You now have an alliteration face!
