

Book title: I'm A Snowplow

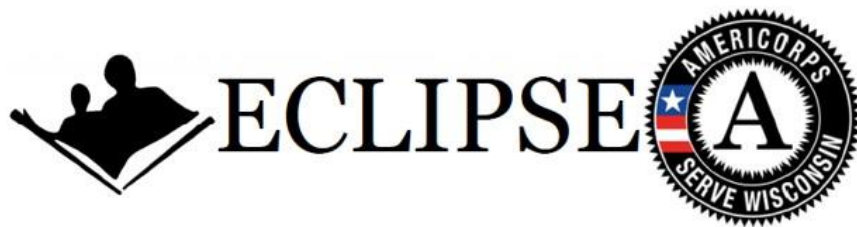

Supplies for activities needed:

- Pipe Cleaners
- Alphabet Beads
- Piece of Paper
- Writing Utensil

Activity Name: Snowflakes

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Spontaneously producing his/her own rhymes
  - Following Simple Instructions
  - Playing with and Manipulating Words and Sounds
- Instructions
  - Take four pipe cleaners of any colors that you want and twist them together in the middle to form a snowflake-like shape.
  - Next, find the letters that will spell out the word "SNOW" and lace them so one bead is on each end of the snowflake.
  - Then, find the letters that will spell out the word "ICE" and do the same as the previous step.
  - After that, have the child get a piece of paper and write out words that rhyme with "SNOW" and "ICE."
- Extension Activity Ideas
  - Have child find a random letter of the beads and make a word with that letter
  - Find a partner and work together to find rhyming words!

Activity Name: Drawing A Snowman

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Showing interest in simple use of materials
  - Following simple directions
  - Child makes object smaller and bigger and comments on the change
- Instructions
  1. Draw three different size circles on top of each other
  2. Add a face to the top circle
  3. Add arms on the middle circle
  4. Add a hat and scarf
  5. Have child make comparisons on different parts of the snowman
- Extension Activity Ideas

- Create a scene from the story with your snowman
- Make a new story with your scene
