Questions asked during Reading:

- On the cover, we noticed lots of snowmen on the page. Together, we can count out 11 snowmen!
- On page 4, we noticed that the snowman had a droopy hat and droopy arms. Do you have any idea why?
- What do you think snowmen do at night? Do you think they sleep or play? Let's find out! (pgs 3-4)
- Did you notice the snowmen drinking "ice-cold" cocoa? Why do you think they drink "ice-cold" instead of "hot" cocoa? (pgs 7-8)
  - That's right! Since snowmen are made of SNOW, they cannot drink warm liquids or else they will melt!
- We noticed the snowmen having a lot of fun playing snowman games on pages 9 and 10. Do you play fun games with anyone you know? I play sports and other activities with people I know!
- Wow, look at all the snowmen doing tricks on the ice! Can we count them all on pages 11 and 12 like we did in the beginning?
  - Together, we counted 17 snowmen!
- On pages 17 and 18, we noticed all the snowmen having so much fun! Look at their BIG smiles! Can you show me your biggest smile?
- The snowmen sled down a HUGE hill on pages 19-22. Have you ever sled down a really big hill? I know I have!
- The snowman on page 26 looks really tired. Do you remember some of the activities they did at night?
  - I remember some snowmen skating and doing tricks on the ice. I also remember them drinking "ice-cold" cocoa from their snowman mothers!
  - There are a lot more activities that I bet you remember! Awesome work!
