

Try on A Disguise: Paper Plate Masks

Supplies for activities needed:

- Paper Plate
- String
- Glue/Tape
- Coloring Tools (Crayons, Markers, Pencils, etc.)

School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:

- Plans Complex Activities
- Makes and Expresses Choices

Instructions

1. Cut a paper plate in half.
2. Cut out a place for the nose and eyes.
3. Cut in a little bit to both sides (left and right) of the plate to make place to tie the string to.
4. Cut a long piece of string, then cut said piece of string in half. Tie one piece of string to the left of the plate and the other piece of string to the right of the plate using the places previously made as the anchor point.
5. The basic mask design is complete! Color and decorate as the viewer sees fit.
 - a. Izzy goes on to explain how to make a cat/fox design.
 - i. Draw triangle ears and cut them out using the scissors. Glue said ears to the top of the plate mask.
 - ii. Cut out whiskers and glue to the plate mask.
 - iii. Color and decorate as the viewer sees fit.
