Supplies for activities needed:

- A friend or sibling
- A game to play, or toys to play with

Activity Name: Friendly Communication

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Sustaining interactions with other children
- Instructions
  1. Play the game you've decided on, or with the toys you have out.
  2. When you start to play with something new, ask your friend if it's okay for you to do that.
    - a. "Is it okay if I play with trucks for a little while? I'm tired of blocks."
  3. If they do something that upsets you, use your words to tell them that it upsets you.
    - a. "It really upset me that you took my blocks, can you ask next time?"
  4. Or, if they do something that you really liked, tell them!
    - a. "I really liked when you asked me to build a block tower with you! Let's do that again."
