

Supplies for activities needed:

- Dirty clothes
- Laundry Detergent
- Fabric Softener
- Washer
- Dryer

Activity Name: **How to do Laundry.**

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Your child will be able to relate to adults by doing their own laundry.
- Instructions
  1. First have your child grab their dirty clothes and bring them by the washer and dryer.
  2. Next have your child put their dirty clothes in the washer but make sure they do not fill it too full of clothes. After your child has put their clothes in the washer, they can start adding laundry detergent and fabric softener.
  3. Depending on how many clothes they put in the washer, measure out the fabric softener and laundry detergent. You may need to help them the first time to show them how much to put in. After they have it measured out, they can pour it into the washer.
  4. After they have the laundry detergent and fabric softener in the washer, your child can close the washer and start it based on the setting you do laundry.
  5. After the laundry is done in the washer, have your child take the laundry out of the washer and put it in the dryer.
  6. Once the clothes are in the dryer, have your child start the dryer and wait for the laundry to be done in the dryer. After the dryer is done, take the laundry out of the dryer and you are done.
