

## Make your own marble game

Supplies for activities needed:

- Cardboard box with sides
- Markers or colored duct tape
- About 10 marbles
- Exacto-knife

Activity Name: Make your own marble game

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Acting alone, using materials to organize active play involving two or more steps.
  - Initiating interaction with familiar adults
- Instructions
  1. Color a design on your cardboard box. You can use markers or duct tape to make your design. Make sure to make your design pretty big.
  2. Go ask your guardian to help with this step. Cut tiny holes using an exacto knife. Make sure these holes aren't too big or too small.
    - a. The marble should be able to sit in the hole without falling through. I would say cut around 10 holes or the number of marbles you have.
  3. Play the game! Try to get all the marbles into the holes without knocking other ones out.
- Extension Activity Ideas
  - Time how long it takes you to get all the marbles in the holes. Try competing against people around you to see who can do it the fastest.
