

Handprint Flowers!

Supplies for activity needed:

- Green construction paper
- Color of choice construction paper
- Green paint
- Paint brush
- Toilet paper roll
- Pencil
- Glue
- Scissors

Activity Name: Handprint Flowers

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Understanding Speech- Following multi-step directions
- Instructions
 1. Get all your supplies ready
 2. Paint the toilet paper roll green and set aside to dry
 3. Take the color of construction paper of your choice and trace your hand on the paper
 4. Cut out your hand with the scissors
 5. Fold the green construction paper in half and cut a triangle out, this will give you two triangles to use for the leaves
 6. Make a cut on one side of the toilet paper roll and do it on the other side
 7. Glue on the two triangles to the toilet paper roll
 8. Put your handprint in the cuts that were made on the toilet paper roll
- Extension Activity Ideas
 - Talk about the shapes that were used in making flower
