

Paper plate cookie monster

Supplies for activities needed:

- Two paper plates
- White paper
- Paint or markers
- Scissors
- Googly eyes (can just draw eyes on)
- Glue or tape
- Something small for the cookie monster to “eat” (could be m and m’s, skittles, cereal pieces, etc.)

School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:

- Following multi-step or complex directions

Instructions:

1. With help cut out a half circle in one paper plate (will be the mouth)
2. Paint or decorate the plates how you wish
3. Cut out teeth from paper, can be whatever shape that you wish
4. Glue or tape the two plates together with the tops facing each other, this should create a space between the plates
5. Glue or tape the teeth on the inside of the plates
6. Glue or draw on eyes, however many you wish
7. Feed the cookie monster your treat (with parent permission you can eat with your cookie monster)

Extension Activity Ideas:

- Working on fine motor skills
- Working on numbers, counting the number of eyes and teeth
