Supplies for activities needed:

- Cardboard/ paper
- Paint + Paint brushes
- Scissors

Activity Name: DIY Puzzle 1.

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Showing persistence, trying several methods to solve a problem
- Instructions
 1. First, use your paint and create a colorful rainbow on either paper or cardboard.
 2. When done, let the paint dry!
 3. Once the paint is dry, use a pencil and outline different shapes over the painting. I used triangles.
 4. Cut out the shapes that you have outlined.
 5. Now, put the pieces together! Talk about the different ways to match pieces, and what to do when they don't match! Keep trying different methods until complete.
- Extension Activity Ideas
 - If you do not have access to paint, you can draw a rainbow using pens, markers, or anyother utensil you would like.
 - If you have put the puzzle together many times, see if you can use the cut out pieces of cardboard to create houses or different kind of buildings.
