

Supplies for activities needed:

- An object of your choice to use to measure
- A room or other object to measure

Activity Name: How Big is That?!

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - The child uses a conventional or unconventional measuring tool and states the results.
- Instructions
  1. After watching the video, have your child find a random object around the house that they can use to measure different things around them.
  2. Have them take that object and measure something around the house, such as a wall or a couch. They can then find out how many of those objects it takes to measure it.
    - a. Ex: "This wall is 10 books long." Or "This couch is 5 blocks tall"
- Extension Activity Ideas
  - Have your child find the dimensions of a room.
    - Ex: "This rooms is 15 books long, 10 books wide, and 50 books tall."
  - You can even compare the unconventional measurements to actual measurements on a ruler
