Activity Name: Be the Animals

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - Using simple sentences of more than two words
- Instructions
 1. Choose one of the animals mentioned or pictured in the book. What do you think these animals do?
 - a. Lobsters, Crabs, Fish, Black Bears, Deer, Elk, Loons, Dolphins, Manatees, Turtle, Pelican, Bull Shark, Alligator, Snail, Panther, Rabbit, Shrew, Woodpecker, Salamander, Great Horned Owl, Seal, Porpoise, Eagle
 2. Think of what the animals do. Does it fly? Does it live in the water or on land?
 3. Tell someone something that your chosen animal does. For example: "The dolphin swims!"
 4. After deciding what your animal does, act it out! Pretend to swim around like a dolphin, or fly like an owl.
 5. Add more details for more fun. For example: "The dolphin swims around the boat" then pretend your coffee table is a boat in the water and swim around it.
