

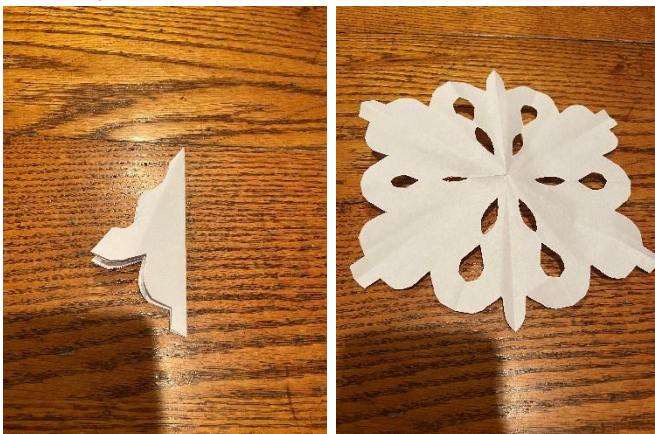
How to Make a Paper Snowflake

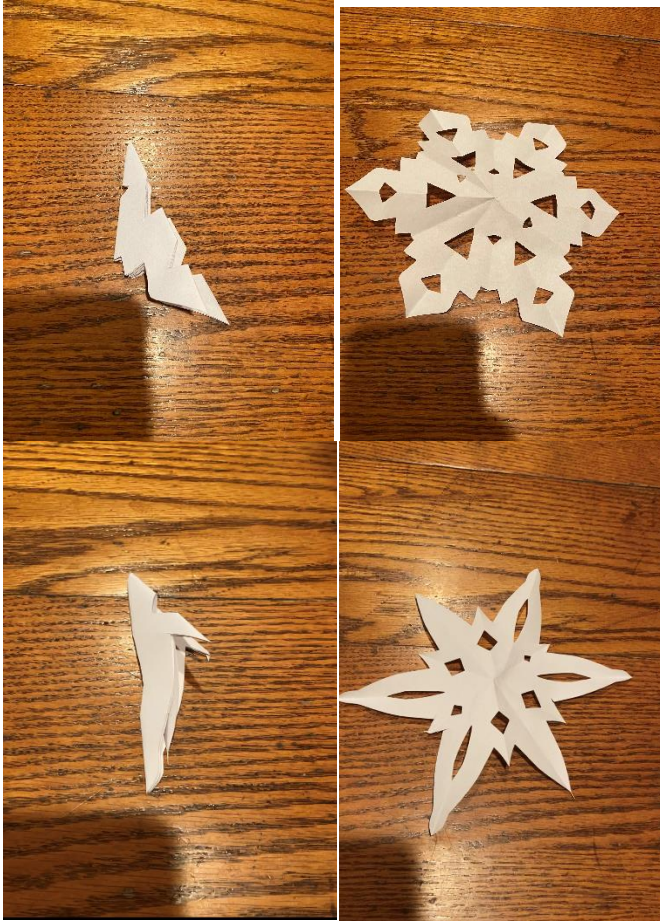
Supplies for activities needed:

- Paper
- Scissors

Activity Name: Paper Snowflakes

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
 - The child identifies repeated patterns or graduated series.
- Instructions
 1. Take one piece of paper and make it into a square. Do this by folding the paper into a right-angled triangle and cutting the excess paper off.
 2. Fold the square piece of paper diagonally in half to create a triangle.
 3. Fold your new triangle in half to make a smaller triangle.
 4. Fold this triangle in thirds. Begin by folding one side of the triangle to the center of the original triangle. Then take the other side and overlap it with the side you just folded.
 5. Cut the pointed ends on the bottom in a straight line to create a triangle.
 6. Make cutouts in this triangle however you would like.
 7. Unfold your paper to reveal your unique snowflake!
