Supplies for activities needed:

- A daily (or frequent) activity to make a routine for.
- Paper
- Markers

Activity Name: Routine Drawing

- School Readiness Outcomes (SRO) goals met:
  - Participates in routines
- Instructions
  1. Choose a routine that you do everyday, or often. This might be brushing your teeth which is more simple, or getting ready for bed which has more steps.
  2. Once you have your activity, ask an adult to help you think of all the things that you do for that activity.
    - a. If you chose getting ready for bed, you might change into your pyjamas first, then brush your teeth, and then go to the bathroom and wash your hands before getting into bed and tucking yourself in. Or you might do things in a different order. Write down the order that you do things!
  3. Draw each step in your routine. This will help you remember your whole routine! If you think you forgot a step, just check your drawing.
